A LITTLE HISTORY

The Community Foundation (SJICF) was a founding partner of the Peace Island Medical Center (PIMC) which was constructed tax-free entirely of charitable monies donated through SJICF and PeaceHealth a nonprofit healthcare provider.

SJICF raised an initial \$10,500,000 used for purchase of the campus and construction of the clinic and hospital. Subsequently, as the authorized hospital foundation, SJICF has raised over \$1,000,000 used for a variety of capital and operational aspects of PIMC. Some of these include, the Cancer Center, the Hepp House (for visiting physicians and specialists), Diagnostic Equipment and Landscaping the Campus.
