SAMPLE "LETTER OF INSTRUCTION TO THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS"

To simplify the process of creating and updating your will to reflect your evolving wishes for your final gifts it may be convenient to make a simple bulk bequest to a Community Foundation Fund and leave the detail specification of your desires to a "Letter of Instruction" to the Foundation. That way you can save some of the legal expenses involved with placing those potentially changing wishes directly in your will.

The following is a sample of what that letter might contain. We request that you arrange a meeting with the Foundation Executive Team to review your letter in detail so as there is a common understanding and accurate implementation of your final wishes.

I hereby appoint the following person(s) as my succeeding advisor with whom the Foundation can consult to best determine my final wishes. I understand that such advisor has no legal authority to direct the Foundation to any action but only will serve as a source of information for the Foundation Board's consideration.
