HELPING OUR COMMUNITY IN THE TIME OF COVID-19

For more than 25 years, SJICF has been dedicated to improving and enriching life on San Juan Island.

2020 has been an especially challenging year, but SJICF has remained committed to meet the urgent and growing needs of our community as a result of COVID-19.

Here are a few things we're doing to help:

1) Established an **Emergency Response Fund** which helped provide:

- 4,316 meals for 103 local children in need of nutrition assistance
- 676 deliveries of food, cleaning supplies, and medications to vulnerable islanders
- 144 utility assistance grants for local households
- 86 rental/mortgage housing assistance grants, helping 276 islanders

2) Created and maintained a **Community Response Hub**, an online resource for residents, businesses and nonprofits at sjisland.recovers.org.

3) Designed and hosted weekly **Nonprofit Emergency Coordination** virtual meetings covering critical community topics like food security, childcare, jobs, and the economy.

4) Published regular **Community Response Updates** for our donors and the entire island via press releases and e-newsletters.
